### **Notice:**

Update 08 08 21

We hope those sailors that were afloat today had a good shake down sail and are looking forward to the start of the racing tomorrow. We wish to bring to your attention a few points that will ensure an efficient and safe regatta.

### **Flight Assignments**

Each sailor must have their coloured flight assignment on their mast before launching. Boats will not be released from the boat park without their flight assignment visible. Flight assignments are posted on the ONB.

### **Sailor & Trolley Tags**

All sailors have been issued 3 tags coloured Blue or Red with your Sailor ID. If you are Red, you launch from the Royal St. George Yacht Club, Blue from the National Yacht Club. Each boat must have a tag attached to their bow and one to the trolley at the front. The remaining tag is for the sailor. Please make sure that you know your ID.

### **Launching**

Sailors must have their boat fully rigged before leaving the dinghy park, this includes your main sheet and rudder if possible. Remember to check that your bung is also in place. The slipways at both clubs are small and launching is delayed by sailors not being ready to sail off, please be rigged and ready to sail.

The slipways will be open for launching 1.5hrs before the first gun. Please give yourself time to launch and sail to the racecourse.

### **Recovery**

As you are aware, our slipways are small so please take your time recovering, if the

slipway looks full, sail away, and return later to avoid damage to your boat. We will safely recover all boats, but sailor's patience and understanding are required.

'Any trolley, Any boat'

Until the final day of the Championships, you will be recovering with any trolley so that there is a quick recovery. On the final day, your personal trolley (as identified by your ID tag) will be returned to you. Please cooperate with this, your understanding will be appreciated.

Parents and supporters are encouraged and welcome to assist with launch and recovery. Make yourself known to any of our team and we will be sure to give you our ***Céad míle fáilte*** and welcome you to our team.

### **After racing food**

There will be sailor food available after sailing on the Carlisle Pier for sailors with Red tags, and at the National Yacht Club for sailors with Blue tags.
