## **Question:**

Penalty (rule 44.3)

Does exclude the use of on-the-water exoneration? E.g. if there is a close port starboard and the port boat is protested are they able to take a one turn penalty to exonerate?

## **Answer:**

RRS 44.3 takes the place of RRS 44.2 (Penalty turns). Under RRS 44.3, a boat receives a 20% penalty if they acknowledge that they have broken a rule of Part 2 (Right of way rules) or rule 31 (touching a mark). The penalty turn exoneration is NOT available under RRS 44.3.
