Hearing decision 6 Muskox request for redress. Checkmate clearly radioed no assistance required relayed by Darkwood to Race Committee. In race3 first downwind leg Muskox severely wrapped their kite on gybing, completed first downwind leg with wrapped kite half down. They then went upwind with kite still wrapped and unable to hoist jib. As a result they were significantly behind the fleet and in last place at the second rounding of windward mark. By all means give them last place but we believed at the time ignoring the earlier radio broadcasts and advising race committee of their intention to offer assustance was a ploy to obtain redress given they were so far behind.
