PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Diego Yubero, Rules Advisor of Spain attended the hearing as observer. ESP 27 presented video evidence during the hearing.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. POL 26 and ESP 27 were both on port tack on a beat to windward.
- 2. POL 26 was clear astern and to windward of ESP 27.
- 3. ESP 27 lifted her kite and luffed.
- 4. POL 26 became overlapped to windward of ESP 27 and lifted her kite.
- 5. ESP 27 passed head to wind and reached the closehauled course on starboard tack.
- 6. POL 26 lowered her kite and continued sailing her course.
- 7. At no point during the incident the distance between them was less than 10 metres.
- 8. There was no contact.
- 9. No kiteboard took a penalty.
