I just found out I was scored DNC allegedly because I did not round the leeward mark. It is true I stupidly missed this mark (for reasons that are irrelevant) but I turned and sailed close hauled on starboard tack to a position above the mark where I would have been had I come straight from the jibe mark to this mark and then rounded it to port as required. Perhaps the race committee thought that I was a spinnaker Shark and was coming direct down wind. I was coming from the jibe mark on a reach and therefore I "rounded" the mark exactly as I would have coming from that direction. It was more like an "L" than a "U" but I repeated the rounding I would have made. Does the mark rounding in this situation require one to go 360 degrees around the mark? I had not touched the mark. If that is the case, can you tell me what rule requires me to go completely around the mark?
