Scoring Inquiry:

I was given a penalty for checking in late. I signed in 6 minutes past the protest time limit due to the following reasons:

1. My trolley was missing when I returned to shore. After looking for a long time everywhere, it turned out that an overseas sailor from Hong Kong had taken it and had pulled it all the way up to NSC. She didn't want to return it because she didn't want to move her boat to another trolley, so she asked if she could continue using it until the end of the regatta. I had to look for another spare trolley but the only trolley I could find was broken, rusted and very heavy. It took a long time to pull it up the shore.
2. In the meantime, while dealing with my missing trolley, I also noticed that an injured sailor had left her boat floating on the water because she had to run to get medical attention for her injuries. The boat was getting flooded and another sailor (Jade Yeh) was trying to help pull it out but was not able to because it was too heavy and her back was hurting. I and Jonathan Kwok took over from her and helped to bail water and pull the boat out. It took a lot of time because the boat was full of water.

After helping to pull the boat out, I continued to drag my boat on the broken trolley up the shore. At that point, the sailor who took my trolley came to look for me to discuss the return of my trolley after the regatta.
