### Scoring Inquiry:

□ ORC 2025 Rule—Determining Placement in the Event of a Tie-Breaking:

According to the ORC Racing Rules (Appendix A8):

1. In the event of a tie, the boat with the greater number of best finishing positions (i.e., more first, second, etc.) wins.

2. If the tie still exists, the results from the last race are compared, and the boat with the better result in the last race is ranked higher.

---

Now let's apply this to your data:

Yacht R4 R5 Points Best Place Last Race

LAGERTHA 3 5 8 3rd 5th

CHOCOLATE 2 6 8 2nd 6th

1□ Both have the same total – 8.

2□ According to the first criterion (best place), CHOCOLATE wins (2nd vs. 3rd).

3□ The second criterion (last race) is not even needed, since the first already decides.

---

□ Conclusion according to the ORC 2025 rules:

if the total points are tied (8), CHOCOLATE is ranked higher, since it has the best individual place (2nd).

□ Therefore, CHOCOLATE is in 3rd place at the end of the third day.
